Hazard	Risk/s	Actions to reduce risk
Moving vehicles and cyclists	Injury to volunteers when setting up road closure, or to children when playing	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Parents to be clearly informed they are still responsible for children's safety.</li><li>2. All volunteers to wear high visibility jackets</li><li>3. Road closure points to be clearly marked with traffic cones and appropriate signage</li><li>4. Road closure notices and door to door leafleting prior to event to warn neighbours in advance of the road closure</li><li>5. Children to be asked to stay out of the road until ALL road closure points in place</li><li>6. Volunteers to alert each other and ensure there are no children in the road if a vehicle needs to pass through the road closure, before removing the barrier</li><li>7. Cars passing through the barrier to access their property to be slowly led to a parking spot by a steward.</li><li>8. Full steward briefing by event organisers to cover every point of the risk assessment</li></ol>
