What are play streets?

<u>Play streets</u> are short, temporary road closures, usually organised by neighbours on their own street, creating a safe space for children to play out together on their doorstep.

Why now?

Outdoor play is vital for children's health and wellbeing, and play streets are an ideal way for children and communities to reconnect. They give children a huge amount of what they need to be happy and healthy; they have long term effects on physical activity, mental health, friendships, independence and a sense of belonging in their communities. Play streets addresses pre-existing barriers to children's freedom to play out; such as increased traffic and fears around safety of children.

Children need time, safe space, and permission to play out. Play streets tick all these boxes so we would love to see more happening across the UK this summer!
